

## ABOUT THE INDIANA CHAPTER

Chartered March 13, 1974, the Indiana Chapter of the Association of Legal Administrators (ALA) celebrated its 35<sup>th</sup> Anniversary in 2009. The chapter has grown over the years to approximately 75 members from private law firms, government agencies and corporate legal departments throughout Indiana. You must belong to the international ALA organization to be eligible for membership in the Indiana Chapter.

The Indiana Chapter was formed to provide a forum for local professionals in legal management to come together and work with other members of the same profession. A local affiliation provides members with a source for networking, interchange, education, training, fellowship and support in handling the day-to-day business of legal management. The members actively work to follow and enhance the professional ethics established at the national level.

## BENEFITS OF MEMBERSHIP

Each year, the Chapter publishes a Legal Support Compensation & Benefit Survey of non-lawyer positions in Indiana law firms. This survey, compiled by an independent accounting firm, is distributed to almost 300 practitioners throughout Indiana's 92 counties. It contains information about salaries, benefits, paid holidays, work hours, as well as other data of interest to law firm managers. Responses are based on the 12-month period ending each June 30 and are reported by population size of the cities in which responding firms are located. Members may purchase this survey at a deeply discounted price.

The Chapter holds monthly meetings in Indianapolis that are educational in focus. Expert speakers address topics or cover current trends in every realm of legal management that is important to leaders in the legal profession. Several times a year, focused round-table discussions are held as a forum to share ideas with other law firm managers. The meetings also provide a great opportunity to take a moment away from the frantic pace of our offices and enjoy networking with friends and peers.

Periodically throughout the year, we offer additional educational seminars and Chapter-sponsored tele-seminars and webinars conducted by ALA International.
